

SAPS: South Africa's most corrupt State department

The South African Police is seen as the most corrupt government department with most people being prepared to - or having already - paid bribes to them according to research by Transparency International published in *Business Live*.



The survey was conducted in six southern African countries and according to its findings more than half of those that had contact with the public service were asked to pay a bribe in the past year. On a positive note, according to the *Business Live* report, more than 80% of people said that they were prepared to get involved in the fight against corruption.
