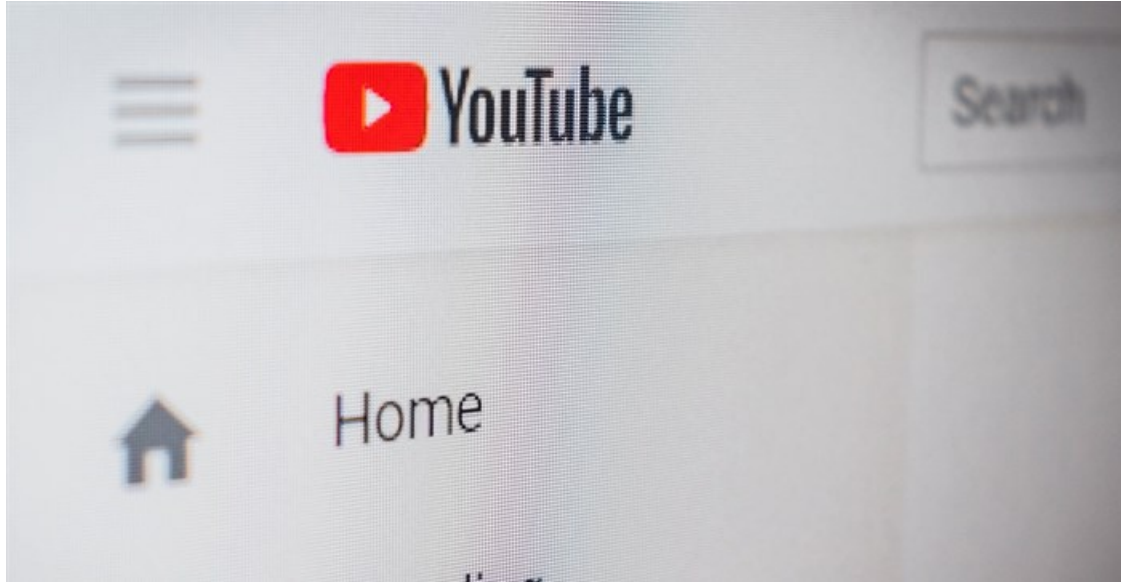


Neal Mohan to step into YouTube CEO position
