From the beginning of 2013, founder and brainchild David Scott has had great success in the South African music industry, racking up a total of three Sama nominations and 10 singles - playlisted across national radio stations - all of which have reached top 10 status in the top 40 charts.

Scott founded the project in early 2011 when he arrived in Cape Town to pursue a career in music.

The Kiffness headlines K-Day this weekend in Cape Town and has a Number One song on iTunes at the moment with his new single "Wiggle A Bit" with Nathan Ro. I caught up with Scott on Friday.
