

Startups winners at AppsAfrica.com Innovation Awards

African startups Flare, Snapplify and Flutterwave were among the winners at the AppsAfrica.com Innovation Awards, which took place in Cape Town last night.



Over 300 entries were received for the awards, which were last night narrowed down to 10 winners. The finalists were judged by an independent panel of leading industry experts.

Kenyan emergency response startup <u>Flare</u> was winner of the Best Social and Messaging Award, while South African e-books startup <u>Snapplify</u> won the Educational Award.

Nigerian payments startup <u>Flutterwave</u> won the Fintech Award, while other winners included <u>Vodacom e-School</u>, <u>Boomplay Music</u>, <u>What3Words</u>, <u>Mazady</u>, <u>Jumo</u> and <u>Bounce News</u>.
